



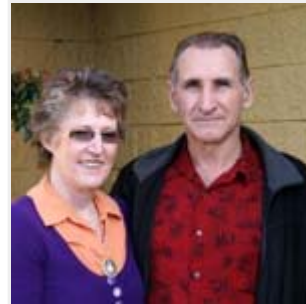
Hello and welcome once again to VANA news...

Can you envision a land where poverty, hardship, hunger and a lack of resources both spiritually and physically is a way of life for children?

This is a challenging ministry opportunity that God has presented to Laurie and Jenny.

The intention is that Laurie and Jenny will be at VANA for a term of up to 3 years. During this time Laurie and Jenny will be living in the Chivhu Community at the VANA Childcare Centre.



Laurie's role will be to oversee the property construction and maintenance. With his background being in building and construction we are very excited to have Laurie on board and overseeing this process. We anticipate that through Laurie's expertise that our vision to complete construction of 30 homes at the Centre and extended community facilities such as a medical centre and library will be well on the way to being realised.

Jenny will oversee some of the community and child care centre programs, and assist in the managing of the general welfare of the children. As a teacher Jenny will bring invaluable experience to loving and serving the children and they will enjoy her teaching and her nurturing as a "mother".

We know that both Laurie and Jenny have a big heart of compassion for His people around the world, and the exciting part is that not only do they have the opportunity to make a difference to the children of Chivhu, you too have opportunity to share in this ministry in several ways.

- First, you can pray for Laurie and Jenny and their mission. They will need prayers that God will prepare them for their mission and bless their efforts as they minister to the children and wider community of Chivhu.
